



## Modern Slavery Act Statement

This statement is made by Eclipse International, Inc. on behalf of itself and its subsidiaries (collectively "Eclipse") pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (the "Act") for the financial year ending 31 December 2025.

It sets out the steps that Eclipse has taken during the last financial year to minimise the risk of modern slavery and human trafficking from taking place within our business or our supply chains.

## **Our Business and Structure**

Eclipse International, Inc. specializes in the dynamic world of commodity brokering. We connect clients to essential markets, facilitating trades in a comprehensive range of energy, softs, and environmental products including but not limited to: Natural Gas, Crude Oil, North American Crude Grades, Refined Products, Coffee, European Cross Commodities, and Environmental Compliance/Voluntary Markets.

We operate across Europe and The Americas, with 3 offices located in London, NYC, and Houston.

## **Our Values**

Eclipse is committed to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business dealings. We fully support the objectives of the Act to eradicate modern slavery, which it defines as "slavery, servitude and forced or compulsory labour" as well as "human trafficking".

Throughout our business, we apply high professional and ethical standards that support the protection of human rights. We comply with all laws and regulations applicable to us and will not knowingly engage with or support any organisation that is involved in such activities.

## **Addressing the Risk of Modern Slavery**

Given the nature of our business as a commodity broker and the professional environment within which we operate, we consider that the risk of our direct involvement in modern slavery and human trafficking is low.

Nevertheless, we recognise that risks can exist within our supply chains. We require high professional and ethical standards from our employees and expect any supplier to adhere to the same standards.

- All of our employees are expected to comply with Eclipse's **Business Code of Conduct**, which establishes the principles and standards by which we expect our employees to conduct themselves.
- All suppliers are expected to comply with all applicable laws and provide their services in an ethical manner.

- We are committed to addressing and remediating any instances of modern slavery if identified.

## **Our Suppliers**

Our supply chains primarily consist of providers of professional services, technology, software, and office facilities.

We expect all suppliers that we engage to share our commitment to acting with integrity. Should we identify any instance of modern slavery or human trafficking within our supply chains, we reserve the right to terminate the supplier's contract.

## **Our Policies**

Our **Business Code of Conduct** is central to our commitment to legal and ethical behavior and is applicable to all employees. It outlines our expectations for a fair and respectful working environment.

We maintain mechanisms that encourage employees to raise concerns, in confidence, if they believe that anything illegal or unethical is taking place within our business, which would include any concerns related to modern slavery. We review our policies and procedures periodically to adapt to our evolving business and external environment.
